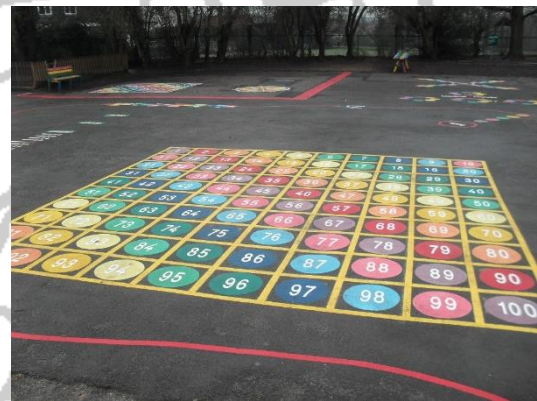
I look forward to seeing you at Parent Teacher Consultation meetings next week.
