The Killigrew Parking Pledge

Parking for many schools can be an issue and our school is no exception. The Senior Leadership Team would like to highlight the importance of safe parking outside our school. We are therefore launching a "Parking Pledge" in September 2017 which we would like parents/carers to sign up to. This is alongside several other initiatives which will be publicised at a later date.

The main aim of the "Parking Pledge" is to promote the concept of responsible parking - which keeps our children safe when they are being dropped off or picked up outside our school. **Our local PCSO will be launching the Parking Pledge initiative before school on the 11th September 2017.**

Before this date we would like all parents to sign up to the safe parking pledge. We will then send you a sticker to display in your car to show your commitment to safe parking at the school. This will hopefully encourage other drivers to do the same. The Senior Leadership Team, alongside a team of Year 6 travel ambassadors, will have the responsibility to monitor the success of your pledge and half termly you will see them carrying out their safety checks!

The Killigrew Parking Pledge

I agree to:

- **Walk to school whenever possible - which may include parking further from the school and walking the last bit of the journey.**
- **Never park, drop off or pick up across the yellow zig-zag lines as this is illegal and dangerous.**
- **Not park on the pavement or the grass verges around the school.**
- **Not block residents' drives – helping us to be excellent neighbours to local residents.**
- **Not drop off on the roundabout outside school as this presents a risk to children's safety.**
- **Support my child in learning road safety rules by leading by example when crossing or using the roads.**

If you agree to the terms of this pledge, please return this slip of paper and we will send your Road Monster Windscreen Sticker home with your child. Under the slip is a map that shows you some places where you may choose to park and then stride to school. Your child should have also brought home a 'Don't be a Road Monster' leaflet for you to look at. Thank you for working with us to keep our children safe.
